We are looking for a scientist with the following qualifications and skills:

- PhD or Master's degree with relevant laboratory experience of at least 1.5 years is required
- Experienced with tissue culture and cell line engineering (ideally w/stem cells, but not a requirement)
- Strong background in molecular biology techniques, including cloning
- Excellent communication skills and the ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Proficiency in flow cytometry and some experience with large-scale screens (e.g., CRISPR or small-molecule screens) are an advantage, but not a requirement.

What We Offer

- We offer a young, dynamic, international work environment and a chance to make an important contribution to basic biomedical research. The contract will initially be limited to one year, with the possibility of extension.
- The position will be fully funded (20 hrs/week) and the salary based on your education and level of relevant work experience, starting from EUR 1,264 (gross per month, 14 times per year).
